

“Children’s play structures are defined as structures without walls consisting of swings, ladders, a slide and other similar play apparatus. They shall be made of quality wood construction. No play surface shall be higher than 4 feet from the original lot grade. No part of the structure shall be shall be higher than 11 feet from the original lot grade. The rectangular footprint of the structure shall be no larger than 275 square feet, including slide. The maximum length in any direction shall be no longer than 20 feet. The structure shall be a minimum of ten feet from all property lines, and shall be placed inside of any fence.”
